What is it?

The **Community Clothing Exchange** is an opportunity to “shop” for gently-used donated clothing, shoes and accessories for the whole family **FREE** of charge – right at SS Peter and Paul Parish. Infant, toddler, youth and adult sizes will be available. We love to recycle!

Who is invited?

Everyone!! SSPP Parishioners and School families, neighbors, friends, relatives – anyone you know who could benefit from **FREE** clothing! No need to donate clothing to attend.

(**Please note:** We will be collecting non-perishable food items at the door of the exchange to help stock our SS Peter and Paul Food Pantry – please help if you can!)

How can I donate clothing to the exchange?

Look through your closets for any clothing that is **gently-used** and that you would still be willing to wear. Please launder the clothing, sort by size and gender, place in a labeled box or bag, and then mark your calendar with the following **drop-off dates and locations:**

Donations may be placed in the open Ss Peter and Paul School garage anytime from 7:00am – 7:00pm **Tuesday, October 4th** through **Friday, October 7th** and the same times **Tuesday, October 11th** through **Friday, October 14th**.

What happens to any leftover clothing?

Any clothing remaining after the clothing exchange will be donated to the St. Vincent DePaul Society and to Our Lady of Black Rock School.

How can I volunteer?

Volunteers are needed in the SSPP School gym to help **set up and sort clothing** on **Friday, October 14th** starting at **2:30pm**. Volunteers are needed to **staff the exchange** during “shopping” hours on **Saturday**, and for **clean up** on **Saturday** at **Noon**.
