The goal of the Little Flowers Club is to teach young girls what it means to be a Catholic girl and eventually a Catholic woman. The badge activities lead the girls in an understanding of the virtues and help them form the habit and practice of living the virtues. The time spent with their Catholic peers in the club gives the girls encouragement in their beliefs, support in their beliefs, and friends with who to share their beliefs.

This is a wonderful group for Catholic girls under the patronage of St. Therese the Little Flower and the Blessed Mother.

Little Flowers Girls' Club program consists of four years of study: Wreaths I, II, III and IV. Each of the first three Wreaths of study consist of nine virtues each. The program is so adaptable that it can be used with multiple age groups. Badges for the virtues are earned by studying the saint associated with the virtue, memorizing relevant scripture verses and studying the Catholic Catechism through crafts, themed snacks, and fellowship.

Our chapter is open to girls in grades K-6.

We meet once a month from 2:00-3:30pm.
