Mrs. Walters' Early Kindergarten Supply List

PLEASE PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN ONE BAG LABELED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME and bring the items with you to orientation: by doing so we will have everything organized for your child on the first day of school.

- ONE Full Size Backpack (**Not** a sports bag or toddler-sized backpack) **MUST** be large enough to fit a folder without having to bend it.
- THREE photos of your child, preferably a close up – for projects (they may be duplicates of the same photo)
- ONE sturdy Vinyl Pocket Folder – other types simply tear after the first month or two
- ONE Spiral bound pkg. of 3 X 5 index cards 50 – 100 cards (for sight words)
- One zipper-style pencil holder
- THREE LARGE size ELMER'S glue sticks – I emphasize Large
- ONE large bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- ONE box of Crayola or Roseart colored pencils – 12 count
- ONE box primary color washable markers
- TWO boxes of Crayola crayons – 8 Pack
- TWO boxes of large facial tissues
- ONE box of quart size zip lock bags & ONE box of gallon size zip lock bags
- TWO containers of flushable wipes
- TWO large containers of antiseptic wipes for cleaning
- TWO large hand sanitizer
- ONE watercolor palette with 8 colors –ONLY Crayola or Roseart, please
- An art smock or old T-shirt for painting – Must be large enough to fit over their uniform. Please Label with name
- ONE black & white composition notebook
- An activity/coloring book of your child's choice (to use during free moments)
- \$20 Cash Activity fee for special projects, speakers' donations i.e. in an envelope labeled with your child's name
- ONE complete change of clothes –including socks placed in a clear large zip lock bag with child's name on the bag –(in an event that there is an accident) Please also label each item with child's name.

We will review the After School Care (ASP) details at orientation. **ALL** children must be registered for the After School Care Program, even if you think you will not be using it. There is always a possibility that you can not pick your child up on time. In the event of an emergency, inclement weather, etc.; the paperwork **MUST** be on file for *each child*.
3. I am requesting two room parents for our class to help organize holiday parties and to set up and maintain a Shutterfly account. Please be thinking if this is something that will interest you, as I will have the sign-up sheet available during orientation.
4. If you have not mailed your completed health and emergency contact, birth certificate, photo release and After School Care forms to school, PLEASE mail them now. I should have them prior to orientation to familiarize myself with each child's individual situation.
5. If you are making monthly tuition payments, please be sure to sign up through the FACTS link on our website. Thank you in advance for your assistance and cooperation.
