NOTE: The following applies if your student attends a school with low student ridership. If we do not take anyone in to a particular school in the morning, we will not pick up at that school in the afternoon, unless notified.

In accordance with New York State Education Law Section 3635, parents or legal guardians residing in Lancaster desiring to have their child transported to a non-public school, must for each child, each year, submit a written request for such transportation by April 1, preceding the next school year. In order to be eligible for transportation, the maximum distance from the student's home to the requested non-public school shall not exceed 15 miles. If the District is already providing transportation for eligible students to a non-public school, transportation may be provided from a central pick up point to the non-public school for those students who live beyond the 15 mile maximum limit.

TRANSPORTATION WHEN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION

The district will not transport non-public school students when the Lancaster public schools are not in session, or when the Lancaster School District or the public school district in which the non-public school is located is closed because of inclement weather.
