



SNOWBALL "TEN COMMANDMENTS"

The below rules are meant to make the SNOWBALL a safe and enjoyable event. Thank you in advance for your support.

We expect parents and students to be responsible for making sure the rules are followed. Kindly read through together.

1. Valid ticket from participating schools required for admission. Chaperones at the evening's event are parents from all involved schools as well as the Catholic High School event leadership team.

2. No ticket sales at door.

3. Appropriate dress required.

Boys will wear a dress shirt and tie with dress pants and shoes. No ball caps. No sneakers. Coat is optional.

Girls will wear a dressy dress /skirt & blouse. Straps strongly advised or a sweater will be necessary for the entire evening. Sweaters will be provided if forgotten. No exceptions. Please leave coats and/or purses in the car unless completely necessary.

4. Please adhere to Pick-up and Drop-off Procedures. READ CAREFULLY. Please do not plan on parking and entering the building .THIS IS FOR SAFETY REASONS ONLY. (If you wish to chaperone, contact your school.)

ENTER EVENT FROM MAPLE RD and EXIT AT ST. GREGORY COURT

For grades 5 and 6 Dance:

Drop off begins at 5:45, no earlier. For safety purposes, please follow drop off procedure. We do not advise parking and walking students into the building, as we have prepared the drop off route to move traffic ensuring safety for all. *Doors close at 6:30.*

Pick up is from 8:00 until 8:20. We have a dance for grades 7 and 8 which begins at 9 pm. Students will be **walked out to the drop off areas by St. Joe's students and parents from each school** to ensure all students are safe and with the correct driver.

For grades 7 and 8 Dance:

Drop off begins at 8:45, no earlier. For safety purposes, please follow drop off procedure. We do not advise parking and walking students into the building, as we have prepared the drop off route to move traffic ensuring safety for *all doors close at 9:30.* No students will be admitted after that time.

Pick up is from 11:00 until 11:20. Students will be **walked out to the drop off areas by St Joe's students and parents from each school** to ensure all students are safe and with the correct driver.

5. **No limousines.** PLEASE go green and carpool with at least two other students.
6. Ticket holders assume all risks of injury, damage, theft or loss of items and releases St. Gregory the Great from any liability thereof.
7. **Students are not permitted to wander or leave the Ministry Center.** Once a student does so, a parent will be called immediately to pick up the child.
8. No smoking or alcohol allowed. Parents will be called immediately to pick up the child.
9. By accepting tickets and entering the premises, appropriate behavior and dancing becoming of young Catholic students is expected at all times. **We reserve the right to dismiss anyone at anytime who exhibits inappropriate behavior or dance.**
10. By accepting tickets and entering the Ministry Center, the bearer implicitly authorizes the Snowball Fund to utilize his/her photo in any and all promotional materials and expressly releases it from any liability thereof.
