MORNING ACTIVITIES

8:00-8:30

- **WELCOME CHILDREN/BREAKFAST TIME FOR CHILDREN WHO BRING A BREAKFAST.**

8:30-9:55

- **MORNING ROUTINE AND CIRCLE TIME**-Children will enjoy language development activities(songs, poems, stories, and fingerplay), daily exercise, and other classroom specific ideas
- **THEME RELATED ARTS AND CRAFTS**-Children will create theme specific arts and crafts under the direction of the classroom teacher and aide. This allows children to develop listening and fine motor skills, as well as, developing their ability to listen and follow oral directions.

10:00-10:15-**SNACK TIME**(snack provided by parents)

10:15-11:30

- **LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT/EARLY LITERACY ACTIVITY**-Children will develop language and early literacy skills through a variety of theme related, teacher designed, "hands on" activities.
- **SMALL GROUP ACTIVITIES**-Children participate in various theme-related learning centers, including arts and crafts activities, dramatic play, fine motor skill builders, and sensory experiences.
- **MATH LESSON WITH MANIPULATIVES**-Children will participate in a variety of theme related, "hands on" math activities with the use of math manipulatives.
