About Our Hybrid Program

Our Hybrid Program allows students to attend in-person classes two days per week (Wednesday and Thursday) and continue their learning at home on the remaining three days. While on campus, students receive instruction in core academic and enrichment subjects from our qualified teachers. On home days, students complete assignments provided by our faculty under the supervision and direction of their parents.

Since hybrid students are registered as homeschoolers with their local school districts, parents are responsible for submitting the following documents: Letter of Intent (LOI), Individualized Home Instruction Plan (IHIP), Quarterly Reports, and Year-End Assessments.

All homeschooled students must complete the school's registration form, and parents must schedule a meeting with the principal to finalize enrollment.

We will supply booklists for each course with purchase links.

This program blends the structure of a school setting with the flexibility of home-based education—supporting both academic growth and family involvement.
